Try not to schedule lessons for a time you know that there will be lots of distractions, or try to let us know if there's a special case so we can try to schedule a make-up for you.

If your child is taking lessons

Try to be present at the beginning of their first lesson and try to get contact info to maintain correspondence if necessary. After the first lesson, still try to be present at the very beginning of the lesson and at the end of the lesson to ensure you and your child know what is expected of them before the next lesson, this will make sure your child remains on a steady path of progress.
